Dear National Federation

World Skate Oceania is extremely proud that our championship host, Freestyle Roller Sports NZ, has been awarded the first World Skate Ranking Event in the Oceania region for scootering. The 2026 Oceania Challenger NZ event will run concurrently with the 2026 World Skate Oceania Championships - Scootering.

FRS completed a rigorous application process with World Skate to achieve Challenger event certification, which Kyle and I wholeheartedly supported. We hope this initiative will also be supported by the national federations across the World Skate Oceania region.

This marks the first time an international ranking event opportunity of this kind has been delivered in the Oceania region.

We understand the importance of World Skate ranking opportunities for riders, and that such events are often limited for athletes in Oceania. Hosting a certified World Skate ranking event within our region is therefore a significant step forward for the growth of scootering across Oceania.

To clarify the event structure: the 2026 Oceania Challenger NZ and the 2026 World Skate Oceania Championships will run concurrently - one event, two podiums, and two final ranking lists.

As outlined in the World Skate bulletin issued to national federations earlier today, all participants wishing to receive 2026 Oceania Challenger NZ ranking points must hold an active Infinity profile or create one to be validated for ranking eligibility.

In addition to World Skate ranking points, podium place getters in Men's Park, Women's Park, Men's Street and Women's Street at the 2026 Oceania Challenger NZ will receive prize money (minimum amounts as listed in the World Skate bulletin) and medals. Junior Park and Street podium place getters will receive prize packs. Results for all categories will be submitted to World Skate for validation.

Podium place getters for the 2026 World Skate Oceania Championships - Scootering will consist solely of riders representing affiliated national federations within the Oceania region - Skate Australia, Skate Fiji, Skate NZ (FRS), and Guam Skate Network. These athletes will receive World Skate Oceania Championship medals.

Please share this information with riders from your national federation.

Early Bird Registration closes this Sunday, 15 February, with the general registration period now closing on Saturday, 7 March.

Cost: NZD \$130 for one discipline plus NZD \$30 to compete in a second discipline.

GENERAL: **16 February 2026, closing 6 March 2026**
Cost: NZD \$160 for one discipline plus NZD \$30 to compete in a second discipline.
