Please find below additional information regarding the 2026 World Skate Oceania Championships - Scootering:

ATHLETE REGISTRATION & COST

Athlete registration for the 2026 World Skate Oceania Championships of Park & Street Scootering has commenced and will close on 6 March 2026.

There will be two registrations periods:

EARLY BIRD:	Open Now, closing 15 February 2026
Cost:	NZD \$130 for one discipline plus NZD \$30 to compete in a second discipline.
GENERAL:	16 February 2026, closing 6 March 2026
Cost:	NZD \$160 for one discipline plus NZD \$30 to compete in a second discipline.

ANTI-DOPING

Doping Control Testing will occur at this event.

The sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the World Skate Anti-Doping Manager and/or Delegate.

All athletes and staff members participating in this event must have completed a valid Anti-Doping eLearning Training Course as designated by their National Federation or the WADA ADEL Course and provide the course Certificate as well as a signed World Skate Anti-Doping Acknowledgement & Agreement Form.

Athletes and staff members who have a current Infinity profile and who competed in the 2025 World Championships in Sakai, Japan will not be required to submit another eLearning certificate or WSK AD Acknowledgement & Agreement Form. National Federations should provide WS Oceania with a list of participants who fall into this group.

All other athletes and staff members participating in this event will be required to submit a valid Anti-Doping eLearning Training Course Certificate (either 2025 or 2026) and a signed World Skate Anti-Doping Acknowledgement & Agreement Form.

Certificates and signed forms **MUST** be uploaded to this [folder](#) by 6 March 2026. Please advise as soon as possible if you are unable to access the folder.

Files should be named as follows as an example:

AUS Certificate - Mary Smith
AUS Form - Mary Smith

NZL or FJI or GUA as required.
